PAC President Report (Jodi)

September Highlights

PAC has been successful in our application for the community gaming Grant and will receive \$5400.

Once deposited into the RBC account this will be transferred to the TD account and the RBC account closed.

Signing authority for TD accounts also needs updating with our new exec.

Issues with RBS statements has led to an accounting error that I have found while writing the 2023-2024 Gaming Account Summary Report. A cheque was made from this account for \$794.75 for hot lunch which should have come from the TD account. We can pay these funds back to the gaming account. I will find out how we go about reporting this to the Gaming Branch.

DPAC (Katie)

- District approved another movie license for 2024/2025. Can do movie nights at the school
- DPAC dinner + workshop event. Up to 4 reps can attend. Childcare provided. Anticipated for late October.

PAC Goals

- Playground upgrade (wooden features)
- Outdoor bleachers: Per Gord, waiting on pricing for bleachers
- Afterschool programs/care support: need ongoing research into this

Old business

- VP position: still open/vacant
- Signing Authority:
 - Updating to remove Aaron and adding Sami (Treasurer)
- Basketball Hoops: was put up a couple weeks ago. Invoice has not yet been given to us.
- Sound system: not yet put up. Waiting on an update from Gord

New business

- Activities
 - Halloween Bash
 - Similar to last year: music, lights, pizza, pumpkin carving contest
 - No photobooth
 - Will add a “quiet room”, waiting to hear back from Gord if a classroom could be available for this
 - Was put out to the Grade 7s, for leadership, to do a spooky room/haunted room
 - Add to Halloween Poster: A notice for those who are sensory sensitive, epilepsy
 - Movie Night for January/February
 - Christmas fundraising:
 - Will do plants and purdys
 - Sami will set up
 - Holiday art cards: Art Cards by Kids - will need to start this right away as it requires teacher involvement
 - Jodi will look into it

 - Indeygo cookies: <https://www.indeygo.com/>
 - Can be hectic managing and storing the cookie dough
 - Can do this for Easter/Spring time instead of Christmas
 - West Coast Seeds (spring): application was submitted on September 16. Will hear back from them in later October/early November. Fundraising campaign date is set for February.
- Hot Lunch: Karen suggested running a bonus hot lunch after a holiday. Karen said Aberdeen notices more sales on the day following a holiday (~15% increase)
- Yearbook Organizing: Ashley is unsure on whether to do just grade 7s, or the whole school. May not be using lifetouch. Ashley will reach out to Tyler (photographer).

Teacher Requests: Approved

- Tiffany Cross: Counting Collection Containers \$175
- Janet McCloy: Document Camera \$150-\$200
- Kathy Costerton: Come Read with Me: up to \$200
- Gord Cumming: Mathletics: \$1968.75
 - PAC will support half: \$984.38 (same as last year)

Teacher Requests: Not Approved

- Gord Cumming: Library Commons Upgrades: \$4500
 - Some of the items listed in the request seem to be more like capital costs. PAC will have Gord to see if there is support from the school district
 - PAC is willing to support library upgrade- some individual, itemized pieces - like foam seating
- Chrome books: approx. 10 devices could be replaced. Cost ~\$3500
 - PAC feels more information is needed and will be willing to replace when required.

PAC discussed doing fundraisers specific to raise amounts for these higher cost requests
